



ITBS Seventh Grade Schedule

* The Iowa Test of Basic Skills is administered to seventh grade students over a nine day period. The entire testing battery takes six hours and forty minutes to complete. Each day, the testing period ranges from 20 to 65 minutes in duration. This minimizes the possibility of test fatigue. The schedule included below identifies the sub-tests that will be administered on each specified day and the content area class in which the testing session will occur. The testing window is April 13 through May 1, which allows time for make-up testing in the event of student illness.
