Friday, February 26– Picture Yourself Reading for Peru

Take a picture of yourself reading and submit it to the school office. We will hang it up on our *Reading for Peru* bulletin board, which will be outside the school cafeteria.



Monday, February 29 – “Leap” into a Good Book 8:00-8:15 AM
