1. Topics/Issues/Projects/Strategic Plan Initiatives Discussed

1. **Faith Sharing** opened the meeting.
2. **Introductions of Current Committee Members and Worship Committee Nominees.** We had 6 nominees present.
3. **Reading of Worship Committee Guidelines.** Guidelines were read by all in attendance.
4. **Review of Worship Committee Strategic Goals.** Discussion of the roles of At-Large Committee Members and the roles of Ministry Reps.
5. **There were questions regarding the strategic goals.** One question regarded the children's missal – is it coordinated with the children's formation program? Molly O'Connell brought up the web seminar series for Eucharistic Ministers. She thought it was very good.
6. **Report for PC.** Judy Kile reported that the major focus is on Robb Lied's appointment as DAS for SJV.
7. In the interest of time, subcommittee reports were omitted and **Camille shared the What Went Well This Year forms** that were returned from the committee members.
 - a. Over all, the committee got high praise, especially in the areas of the church décor and the What's This bulletin articles.
 - b. It was noted that there is a noticeable improvement in hospitality ministers demeanor but it was also noted that more still needs to be done. Over all the hospitality ministry has been spotlighted this year, and while it is getting better, the number of ministers is not where it needs to be. We currently have about 30 hospitality ministers and we should have 40 – 50. We need a minimum of 4 at each Mass, but ideally we would like to have 8.
 - c. It was also mentioned that the Church décor set up and take down is like a well-kept secret. Can more be documented so that people understand what they can assist with? Angela Bravata does a lot of the set up and strategy planning for this. It is working well. It was proposed that creating Standard Operating Procedures (SOP) and documenting what is done and when, would be a good idea for next year's strategic goals.
8. **Minutes were reviewed for February 27, 2017** and there were no corrections.
9. **Archdiocese Ministry Enrichment Gathering.** Camille informed the committee that the Archdiocese is presenting a Ministry Enrichment Gathering on Saturday May 20th at Sacred Heart Parish in Horicon.
