Join us for this two part series with Bishop Robert Barron. There is no charge. Dialogue and Discussion to follow.

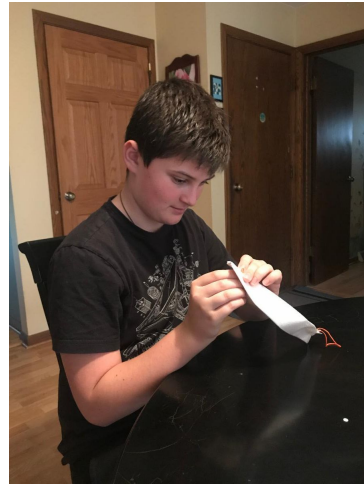

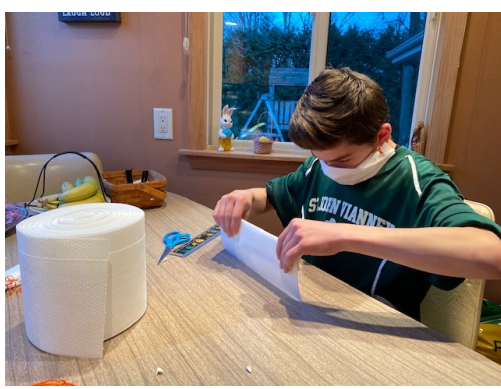
