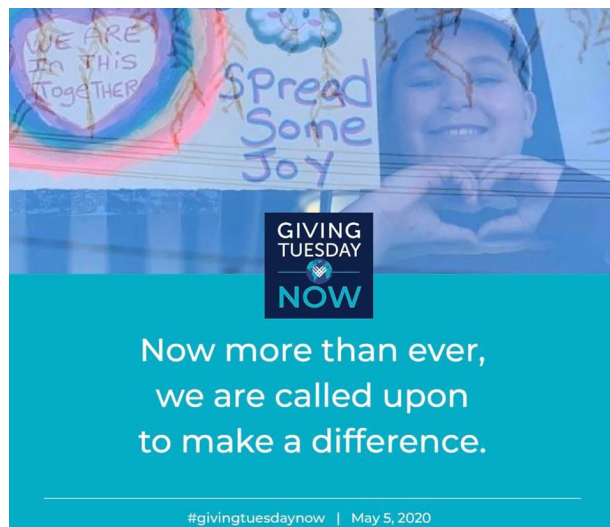
Giving Tuesday Now
